The COP will bear primary responsibility for technical aspects of contract performance, providing central oversight and maintaining acceptable standards of quality for tasks and deliverables. S/he will also be responsible for the management duties of the activity including, but not limited to, budget oversight, financial reporting, and overall compliance with ME&A and USAID contracting requirements. S/he will also be responsible for managing the evaluation's technical team, ensuring production of high-quality reports that meet USAID standards and requirements and directing the evaluation's development. The COP will also bring expertise in coordinating with government entities, partner organizations, and program stakeholders and the ability to work effectively and respectfully with individuals from diverse backgrounds.
